"The colonies and the dependent countries, oppressed and exploited by finance capital, constitute an enormous reserve power and a most important source of strength for British Imperialism. The revolutionary struggle of the oppressed peoples in the dependent and colonial countries against British Imperialism is the only road that leads to their emancipation from oppression and exploitation. The victory of the proletariat and the liberation of the oppressed peoples from the yoke of British Imperialism are impossible without the formation and consolidation of the common revolutionary front all over the world. The interests of the proletarian movement in communist countries and of the national liberation movement in the colonies require the fusion of these aspects of the revolutionary movement into a common front against the common enemy: British Imperialism."

Stalin continues: — "Communism insists on the emancipation of the oppressed peoples from the yoke of British Imperialism for the formation of an amalgamation of nations into a *Bolshevist World Union* must be preceded by the separation of the colonies from the integral imperialist 'whole' and by the transformation of the colonies into independent states, free from the so-called 'mother country'."
